Dear Residents/Family Members,

Our COVID update for this week brings promising news for The Hallmark. We were able to close our COVID unit in Assisted Living yesterday as all residents there have recovered. To the best of our knowledge, the last of our quarantined IL residents are eligible to come off quarantine protocols over the weekend and we are down to 1 staff member still out recovering.

While this is great news for The Hallmark, cases in Houston, Harris County, Texas and across the United States continue to rise so we must continue to be vigilant.

Most of you are aware that the FDA has now officially approved the Pfizer vaccine (and booster) under a new brand name (Comirnaty). The booster is essentially just a third injection of the original vaccine and can now be accessed at various locations. That said, the administration has not indicated how they will distribute to communities like the Hallmark. We continue to work with our vaccine partners and anticipate being able to offer it at The Hallmark at a yet to be determined date. In the meantime, if you proceed with getting the booster somewhere else, kindly let us know so we can document for our records.

We anticipate making a decision sometime next week as to when the dining room will re-open and will communicate that once the decision is finalized.
